- Welcome and introductions:
 Grant Johnson called the meeting to order at 6:30; those present introduced themselves.
- 2. Approval of the August 13 meeting minutes: Alice Honig moved and Damian Vallelonga seconded approval; passed unanimously.
- 3. Fiscal report: Natalie Stetson reported: \$466.18 in checking; \$1,072.05 in planter fund; and \$2,321.20 in savings. Except for a \$25 check for printing, there are no outstanding invoices or anticipated income.
- 4. Neighborhood SPD report:

Officer Bresett reported a significant increase in burglaries and car larcenies. Burglaries have been both forced entry (sometimes with owners at home) and through unlocked doors or window. 3 young men were apprehended whose pattern was to enter SU dorms, set off fire alarms, and rob empty rooms. There have been robberies as well, some involving weapons. Charles and Glenda asked about monitoring of suspected drug activities in the 400-block of Columbus. Officer Bresett said he would find out if any investigation is ongoing Brittany asked about the use of technology—tracking cameras and the like—in the area.
